Group II Moderately hazardous

Group III Slightly hazardous

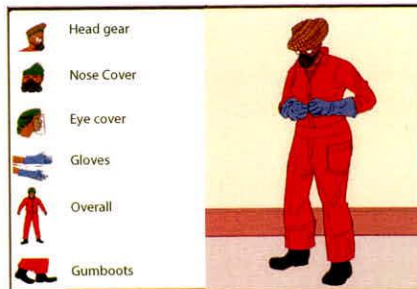

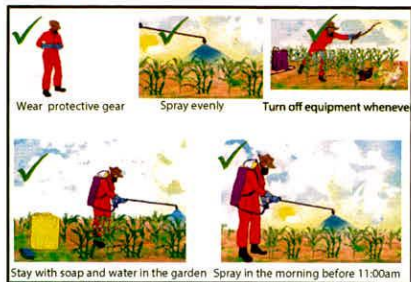
